## Accommodations

The **Radisson Blu Hotel Nydalen** is located just steps away from BI Norwegian Business School and offers a discounted rate for SNDE 2015 attendees, which will be honored until 15 February 2015 -or- when the block of rooms is full, whichever occurs first. In recent years the conference hotel sold out well ahead of the deadline, so we encourage you to book your lodging early.

SNDE 2015 Conference Rate = **NOK 1395** single or double occupancy per night (rate includes Scandinavian breakfast, wireless internet and taxes). Approximate currency equivalent is \$199 USD -or- €162 EUR. Check here for up-to-date currency conversion: <http://www.xe.com>.

The block of rooms for SNDE 2015 will be held until it is full, and no later than 15 February, 2015. After this date the hotel may continue to offer rooms if available but not at the discounted rate. And it is entirely possible that the block will be full prior to 15 February, so please book early.

Attendees who prefer to stay in the center of Oslo can very easily reach BI Norwegian Business School using public transportation. From the Central Station, take metro number 3 toward Storo or metro number 6 toward Ringen. Exit at Nydalen Station, which is across the street from the hotel. The entire trip takes approximately 10 minutes.

## Transportation

Oslo is served by Gardermoen International Airport, located north of the city center. It is easy to reach BI and Radisson Blu Nydalen using public transportation. Refer to the [BI website](#) for details.

### *Express Train from OSL*

We highly recommend taking [Flytoget](#) Airport Express Train to Oslo central station (Jernbanetorget/Oslo S) and then transfer to [T-bane Metro](#) to get to BI and Radisson Blu Nydalen. Take Metro #3 (toward Storo) or #4 (toward Ringen) and exit at Nydalen. The Nydalen Metro stop is across the street from both the Radisson Blu hotel and BI Norwegian Business School. The train ride from OSL (airport) to Oslo S (train station) is 22 minutes and the Metro from Oslo S to Nydalen is 10 minutes, at an approximate total cost of \$35 USD or €25 EUR.

### *Taxi from OSL*

Taxis are expensive, and if this is your preference be sure to arrange a fixed price at the Taxi Information desk inside the airport or be prepared to pay the equivalent of \$200 USD.

## Conference Fee

The early conference registration fee is \$285 USD, and the standard fee of \$375 USD applies to all registrations received after 15 February 2015. The first 15 graduate students who register by 15 February 2015 will receive a discounted fee of \$185 USD.

The fees quoted above represent an early registration discount applicable for payments received on or before 15 February, 2015. Starting 15 February, the fee will increase to the standard rate of \$375 USD. *The higher fee applies to all payments received after February 15*, even if registration was submitted prior to the deadline.

All participants, including those who were invited by members of the program committee to submit a paper, are expected to pay the full fee. One-day registration is not available.

*The registration fee includes:*

- Conference Reception on Thursday evening at BI Norwegian Business School
- lunches on Thursday and Friday
- coffee breaks
- admission to all sessions
- conference materials (including program/abstract book)

Participants who wish to present a paper **must register and pay fees by February 15, 2015**. After February 15, presenters who have not registered will be removed from the program.

The conference reception will take place at BI Norwegian School and is included in the conference registration fee.
